#### PE

# What will your children be learning?

English - We are reading the text 'Little Red Reading Hood' and learning about what goes into writing a narrative story. The children will learn how to build a sentence properly, and the language that goes into it.

Maths - The children are learning all about place value, representing numbers up to 100/1000 visually and verbally. The unit also includes reasoning and problem-solving to build their knowledge.

**ART** We will be exploring drawing by developing and understanding of shading and drawing techniques to create botanical inspired drawings.

**History** We will be looking at the history of engineers! We will be investigating important people including Mary Anning, George Stephenson and Brunel.

**RE** We will be discovering all about the creation story from the Bible.

**RHE** We will be working on 'Valuing Difference', looking at those around us, considering how they feel and displaying acts of kindness

**Science** We are learning all about light! We will discover how light travels, how we see objects and how shadows are formed.

**Music** This half term, we are focusing on singing, looking at different styles of musical influences.

#### **READ WRITE INC**

Read,Write Inc is a phonics programme that we use at Milton Abbot to teach children to read and then write. Teaching phonics helps children hear, identify, and use different sounds. Read, write Inc is our chosen programme to deliver phonics teaching and follows a clear system and methods.

Read Write Inc lessons are already in full swing for children from Barn Owls and some from Tawny Owls. Children enjoy daily phonics sessions from day one at Milton Abbot as we prioritise learning to read and fostering a love of books. You may have already noticed your child coming home with their reading books that are matched exactly to where they are on their reading journey- there will be more information on what to expect your child to bring home and when coming next week. We will also be holding a parent reading workshop this term- date to follow shortly.
